

Results 2015

Overall the students from Blackfriars Academy achieved a very positive set of results which reflects the effort and commitment of staff for all students to do well. Students at all levels achieved accreditation of some sort, ranging from ASDAN Personal Progress, Entry Level 1,2 and 3. A range of Level 1 courses both in BTEC and individual subjects, Level 2 (GCSE) qualifications in which some students achieved a GCSE grade A. So a massive well done to all students this summer, you have done both yourselves and Blackfriars proud.

Results Highlights:

- All students in Class 5 exceeded their targets. Ends of KS4 data aimed for upper P levels and all attained ASDAN Personal Progress which equates to an EL1 qualification.
- **Year 11 KS4**
- **English :**
- FS English approx 66% achieved with either the full or part award. GCSE English students did well with 25% exceeded target and 50% met their target.
- **Maths:**
- Results were as expected but based upon the predicted data and the units achieved students were on task to achieve at the required level.
- **Science:**
- GCSE results were excellent; 25% plus were above the end of KS4 target and the rest met their target.
- **ICT**
- BTEC ITQ results were a positive move for students to achieve their targets. Again this is a new course begun in Y11 and results from this are promising for future entries.
- **GCSE History** – all students who were entered achieved a GCSE pass, 60% exceeded their target and 20% met their target.
- **RE:**
- All students passed EL3 RE and GCSE RE had a 100% pass rate and all students exceeded their target grade.

- **GCSE Art:**
- All students who were entered achieved a GCSE pass. 50% met their target and 50 % exceeded their target.
- **BTEC Creative Media Production:**
- All students passed, 75% exceeded their target achieving a L2 Pass and above, equates to GCSE C and above and 25% met their target.
- **BTEC Home Cooking Skills:**
- All students passed, 75% exceeded their target achieving a L2 Pass and above, equates to GCSE C and above and 25% met their target.
- **BTEC Performing Arts:**
- All students passed, 50% met their target and 50% exceeded their target, students entered for the NQF Level 2 attained Pass (GCSE C) and Merit (GCSE B) grades.
- **BTEC Workskills:**
- Three students attained the full qualification and the rest achieved unit award accreditation. Of all the students certificating approximately 25% were above target and 75% met their target.

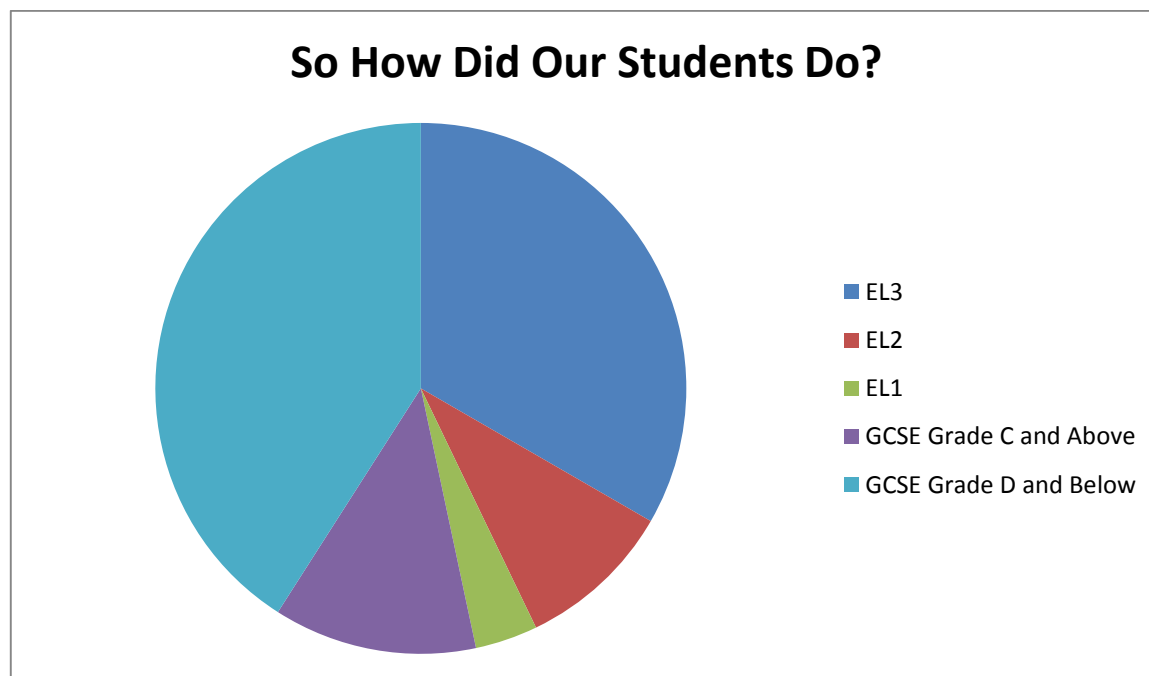

Will – Runcorn College to study Photography


Jack – Reeseheath College to study Horticulture

Jordan – Reeseheath College to study Motor Vehicle Maintenance


Usamah - Newcastle under Lyme College to study ICT


