

Allocation of Pupil Premium 2016-17

Blackfriars Academy receives a sum of money from the government to support the education of students who are in receipt of free school meals (FSM) and those who have received FSM at any time during the previous 6 years. Funding is also allocated for children who are 'looked after' by a local authority.

The additional funding is given so that schools can support particular groups of students who could be at risk of underachieving and work to ensure that the attainment of these students is close to or matches that of their peers. The Primary Need of our students can have an impact upon attainment levels; however the students make good progress from their starting point.

Blackfriars Academy is in receipt of £44,575 for the year 2016-17. 57% (52 students) are eligible for Pupil Premium support.

Our analysis of the cohort of Pupil Premium students shows that they have a wide range of varied needs. The funding is used to support and develop every individual according to their needs to enable progress academically, socially and physically. Two interventions are based around support not only for students but also their parents in the knowledge that our partnership with parents and carers plays a vital role in improving the attainment of students (support of Clinical Psychologist and training through Achievement for All initiative)
