Focus area of PPG spending 2014-15

- To identify students at risk of falling behind their aspirational targets
- To provide targeted support to narrow any gap in progress between different cohorts of students
- To raise the aspirations and self-esteem of students through pastoral support and enrichment activities
- To enable students to control their emotions and behaviour and therefore reduce the risk of exclusion
- To enable students to become successful, independent learners

Specific Nature of Support for PPG students 2014-15

- Identification of students who may fall behind their targets
- Data manager appointed across Multi Academy Trust to support and benchmark student progress
- Clinical Psychologist employed to support individuals with positive emotional health and self esteem
- Educational visits to enhance the curriculum

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

- All students' progress is tracked from Year 7 to Year 11 and is analysed termly
- Our Data suggests there is no discernible difference between progress made by Pupil Premium and Non Pupil Premium Students.
- All Pupil Premium Students in Year 11 achieved external accreditation in at least Maths, English and Science.
- As a School we have recognised that performance within Year 11 Maths is an area for development and this will be achieved through the introduction of Conquer Maths and additional support for the current Maths teacher from within the Multi Academy Trust.
